IBFNA: Later this month Elaine and I will be traveling to Shipshewana, Indiana where I'll be one of the speakers at the annual *Independent Baptist Fellowship of North America* Conference. These conferences are always a source of blessing and encouragement to us as we fellowship with people that we've known and loved throughout the years of our ministry, and have the opportunity to be challenged by the preaching of others.

PRAISE: The first church that we planted when we were serving in Paraguay, South America just celebrated their 38th anniversary. They've gone through some real trials at times but God has kept them through it all. They're struggling financially and we recently had to help them with the purchase of a new projector for their Bible College classes. They have 9 students this year.

MEXICO: In July I will be flying to the southern part of Mexico for two weeks of meetings. First I will be in a town called Huimanguillo (*A on the map*) and then in Comitán (*B on the map*). We have Bible Colleges in both of these



churches. Pray that God will bless the meetings; that souls will be saved and that believers will be challenged to serve God in a greater way.

Churches in Mexico as well as Central and South America have seen the need to plant other churches but they are having trouble finding men to pastor them. As a result they're turning to students who haven't yet completed their studies and calling them to fill the positions.
